On your way to Gålå, visit Maihaugen, one of Europe's largest historical outdoor museums. Experience what Ibsen and other famous artists saw on their journey up Gudbrandsdalen valley.

Program for individual travel

Arrival dates: 30-31 July, 04-07 August 2015.

Day 1

Arrival in Oslo, travel to your choice of hotel in the Lillehammer region.

Day 2

11:00 am Visit Maihaugen, a historical museum.

1:15 pm Guided tour with a cultural element in the Peer Gynt loft at Maihaugen.

2:20 pm Festival-bus - Lillehammer to Gålå.

5:00 pm Dinner at the Peer Gynt festival venue by lake Gålåvatnet.

6:30 pm International introduction to the theater play.

7:30 pm "Peer Gynt" by lake Gålåvatnet.

11:00 pm Bus back to the Lillehammer region and your choice of hotel.

Day 3

Return to Oslo.

Program for group travel

Arrival dates: 30-31 July, 04-07 August 2015.

Day 1

Arrival in Oslo. Travel to Lillehammer.

2:30 pm Guided tour with a cultural element in the Peer Gynt loft at Maihaugen.

Travel to your choice of hotel.

Day 2

Daytime: Hiking, horseback riding, rafting or other activities. Activities depend on choice of hotel.

5:00 pm Dinner at the Peer Gynt festival venue by lake Gålåvatnet.

6:30 pm International introduction to the theater play.

7:30 pm "Peer Gynt" by lake Gålåvatnet.

11:00 pm Return to chosen hotel.

Day 3

Return to Oslo.

The theatre play is suited for international audience through international introduction, a full summary booklet and an audio guide.



Explore more of Norway, Ibsen, Grieg and Munch.

Ibsen, Grieg and Munch come together in the stage play "Peer Gynt" by lake Gålåvatnet.

Grieg wrote the music for Ibsen's drama, and Munch was inspired by scenes from the theater play in several of his paintings. Explore Norway with these three grand masters in Norwegian culture.

Day 1

- * Oslo: Travel to your choice of hotel.
- * Visit the Ibsen Museum.
- * Visit the Munch Museum.

Day 2

- * Oslo to Lillehammer, approx. 184 km.
- * Guided tour with a cultural element in the Peer Gynt loft at Maihaugen.
- * Travel to your choice of hotel.

Day 3

- * Daytime: Hiking, horseback riding, rafting or other activities. Activities depend on choice of hotel.
- * Dinner at the Peer Gynt Festival venue by lake Gålåvatnet.
- * Introduction to the theater play.
- * "Peer Gynt" by lake Gålåvatnet.

Day 4


- * Travel to Kaupanger, approx. 243 km from Vinstra. Prolong for one day, or continue to Bergen.
- * Fjord cruise from Kaupanger to Gudvangen, approx. 2,5 hours.
- * Gudvangen to Bergen, approx. 147 km.

Day 5

- * Visit Edvard Grieg's home, "Trolldhaugen".
- * End of a marvelous journey.
